


#### About SYNLawn

### **Australian Manufacturer Warranty**

All SYNLawn products come with a standard Manufacturer's Warranty of up to 15 years (depending on the product). Our Warranty protects customers against issues such as ultraviolet degradation and fibre loss.

We offer a simple and supportive Warranty Claim process. A claim may be lodged anytime during the Warranty period, by notifying us in writing as soon as possible. Within 15 days of notification, one of our SYNLawn representatives will arrange a time for a joint inspection to fairly assess the claim. If the claim is approved, SYNLawn will happily replace the product to the same or equal value.

# Coolplus® technology

All SYNLawn products feature proprietary infraredreflective COOL*plus* sports yarn technology, which reduces the surface temperature by 10-20% compared to competitor products.

Sunlight is comprised of a wide spectrum of radiation including visible light, UV radiation and infrared (IR). Infrared radiation causes molecular vibration, which translates into heat energy when it is absorbed by an object.

Our proprietary COOL*plus* yarn technology does not absorb infrared rays, translating into less molecular vibration and cooler surface temperatures.

Our COOL*plus* technology also creates more of a matte finish to the synthetic fibres, reducing the often shiny appearance of artificial grass. Our premium surfaces are also softer to touch and less abrasive than other artificial grasses.





All SYNLawn products are free of unsafe chemicals and are soft to touch and play on. We specialise in supplying and installing artificial grass for schools, childcare centres and playgrounds.

We offer soft shock pad underlay when installing the grass for added cushioning and protection.



# **Pet-Friendly**

All of our products are safe and pet-friendly. Soft under paw, toxic-free and incredibly durable, they are designed to withstand even the most active of pets!

Our safe odour-eliminating infill and spray system keeps unpleasant pet waste and ammonia smells under control. And liquid drains right through the synthetic pile with no pooling, which means no brown stains, mud or puddles.

Of course, maintenance is still required to keep your artificial grass looking it's best and to ensure longevity.

## **Superior Drainage**

Let it rain! Water (or any other liquid) drains right through our surfaces at a rate of 2000mm per hour.

The punch hole system on the backing of our surfaces quickly allows water to pass through the pile into the ground below, preventing growth of mould and bacteria.



#### **SYNLawn Installation**

Installing SYNLawn artificial grass can be an easy and fun DIY project. By following these instructions, you can create a beautiful, low-maintenance and environmentally-friendly landscape that you enjoy all year round.

If you are not confident at installing the grass yourself or your installation area is greater than 25sqm, we highly recommend using a SYNLawn Certified Installation Professional. Large installations can be very labour-intensive and often require specialised skills. Contact SYNLawn on 1300 796 529 to find your nearest Installation Professional. We have Professionals available Australia-wide.

Before installing your SYNLawn artificial grass, make sure you have all the equipment required, as listed:

#### SPECIALTY TOOLS NEEDED

- Everseal adhesive tape (5LM or 20LM)
- 150mm flat head nails or landscape pegs
- Turf rake (for bristle fibres)
- Sand spreader
- Vibrating plate (hire)
- Dried silica sand

#### **COMMON TOOLS NEEDED**

- Stanley knife
- Hammer
- Yard rake
- Shovel
- Wheelbarrow
- Tape measure
- Wide shop broom



#### Prepare the base

Excavate the area to a depth of 80mm. Lay 80mm of crushed rock/road base and compact it with a vibrating plate. The level of crushed rock/road base when compacted should be 15-20mm below "finished height" of surrounding edging/paving.



#### Trim to size

Lay your artificial grass, making sure you start from one edge and roll out. Cut the over-hanging quantities with a sharp stanley knife. Remove the "salvage" or black strip from both sides of the grass. This cannot be used to join the grass.



#### Glue seams together

When joining rolls of grass together, be sure to use Everseal adhesive tape along the seams. Lay the silver backing of tape down on the crushed rock/ base with the white side facing up. Place the two pieces of grass onto the tape, with each edge placed evenly in the centre of the tape. Remember to put pressure onto the seams once the grass has been joined to promote good adhesion.



#### Secure in place

Once you have covered the complete area, nail all of the perimeters down at 500mm intervals using flat head nails or landscape pegs.



#### Groom your grass

Using a sand spreader, top dress the grass with an even distribution of dried silica sand fill to a depth of 15-20mm. A yard broom can be used at this stage to sweep in the sand evenly and to also brush the grass blades straight.

#### IMPORTANT:

- Do not attempt to lift the grass by yourself. It is advised that the rolls be cut into manageable lengths before moving.
- Always run grass in the same direction.
- Refer to the Product Specification sheet for recommended amount of infill required.
- This installation information has been supplied as a reference guide only. SYNLawn Warranties do not cover installation.

#### **SYNLawn Maintenance**

Whilst the upkeep of artificial grass is not as time-consuming and costly as natural grass, it does still require a little maintenance, often.



SETTLEMENT It will take 2-3 months for your new artificial grass to settle and reach its optimal condition. During this period the infill materials penetrate the fibre pile and settle into the turf structure. Light grooming, using a medium soft bristle brush, on a regular basis, will help the pile remain upright and aid infill settlement.

**BRUSHING** The main reason for brushing is to stimulate the top fibres of your artificial grass, helping them to remain vertical. We recommend light brushing at least once every month and performed in multiple directions.

Some infill may appear on the top of your artificial grass from time to time. Light brushing will settle it back down.



DEBRIS Debris should be removed from your artificial grass on a regular basis to prevent organic matter building up in the turf structure. We recommend debris removal at least once every week and can be performed with a leaf rake and shovel, leaf collecting device such as Aussie Clean Sweep or a mechanical blower. Debris build-up may affect the drainage capabilities of your artificial grass system and encourage weed growth.



ANIMAL WASTE Animal waste should be removed from your artificial grass as soon as you find it and the area washed down with a warm soapy solution such as household washing liquid, should it be required. The waste will not damage your artificial grass, but will work its way into the artificial grass structure if left for too long.



STAIN REMOVAL Most stains can be removed from your artificial grass with warm soapy water using household washing liquid.

Heavy oil marks can be removed using mentholated spirits and a cloth. Remember to wash down the cleaned area with water to dilute the spirit residue.



BURNS For superficial burns on your artificial grass, carefully clip the pile with scissors just below the blackened or melted tips. For large deep burns you may need to replace that section of artificial grass. A SYNLawn Certified Installation Professional will be able to assist.



**TREATMENT** If you do start to see moss, algae or weeds growing on or in your artificial grass, we recommend using the following products:

- Weeds: Round Up/Zero this compound is used to control broad leaf weeds and annual grasses. Apply in a wand-like motion directly onto the leaf. Do not spray directly onto it.
- Moss/Algae: Wet and Forget it has a unique combination of biodegradable selective surfactants for moss, mould and gunge removal on any exterior surface.

Please remember to remove all dead matter including roots and sweep debris off the turf.



**VEHICLES** Only light vehicles under 1 tonne, fitted with wide, low-pressure tyres (8 to 10psi) should be allowed on your artificial grass.

**TAKE CARE** We recommend avoiding the use of the following items on your artificial grass:



Glass, tin or ceramics: Broken sharp objects can bury themselves into the turf structure and potentially cause injury or damage to you and your artificial grass.



Cigarettes or hot surfaces: Although your artificial grass has a fire safety rating, open flames and hot items may melt the fibre pile.



Chewing gum: It can be removed by freezing the gum and chipping it off the surface. However it is recommended to avoid having chewing gum on the grass.
